



## Season B- Winter 2021 Spectator guidelines

- Each HOME athlete will be allowed two spectator tickets per game/match/meet.
- Each spirit athlete will be allowed up to two spectator tickets per game dependent upon capacity limitations based on school gymnasium (this could vary from school to school).
- All spectators are required to wear a protective face covering for admission and throughout the duration of the contest. Even while seated, the face covering must remain on at all times. Two people maximum from the same household may be seated together on a designated circle/square.
- Social distancing guidelines of 6 feet apart will be adhered to at all times for spectators.
- All spectators will have their temperature checked prior to entering the event.
- Each spectator will be asked to provide contact information including an email address and phone number for contact tracing purposes.

- No passes will be accepted this season except for CHSAA passes. No employee passes, family passes, CHSCA passes or any other form of pass will be accepted this fall.
- Restroom access will be available with social distancing guidelines in place.
- Once the event has concluded, spectators will be asked to gather their belongings and exit the building. No congregating will be allowed.
- Social distancing signs and directions will be displayed.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available.
- Extra masks will be available at entry gates for anyone who forgets one.
- Facilities will be thoroughly cleaned by Adams 12 custodial crew after each event. Each gymnasium will be sanitized and cleared out for a minimum of 30 minutes between games.
- Please be diligent and take these guidelines seriously so that it gives our students the best chance possible to complete their season without interruption.
