This is the time to be completing or coming close to completing your college applications. November has a lot of **Early Action deadlines**, and it is strongly encouraged you turn in your applications before that. Applying as **Early Action (not Early Decision)** means you will hear back on your acceptance sooner, therefore giving you more time to plan ahead with financial aid.

Don't forget that your **college essays are the most important part to your college application**. Reach out to me if you need some feedback on it!

Connect with admission counselors if you have any questions about the admissions process. Make sure to also **follow up with your counselor** to ensure that your **high school transcript** gets sent.

Tips & Tricks

Create a **Google Drive folder** to put all of your college/scholarship materials in with your personal Gmail. **Calendars and planners** are also very helpful when navigating different deadlines.

ALWAYS USE YOUR PERSONAL GMAIL WHEN APPLYING!

ALWAYS have someone (or multiple people) review your college/scholarship essays. I am more than happy to give you feedback! It is the most important part of your college application!

As you start getting accepted into colleges, you can apply to **institutional scholarships** directly on the colleges' websites. Then, work on Colorado/Local Scholarships, those are less competitive and "easier" to get! Then check out the Diversity Based and then the National!

Check on your email regularly. This is the main way colleges will contact you and share any information about your application.
